- The European Commission has defined “the promotion of gender equality, particularly in local development” as priority theme for 2007 with the objective:
 - encourage balanced participation of men and women in the various aspects of local development, both economic and social
 - implement policies at local level in order to encourage, on a daily basis, the promotion of gender equality
